



Topic Overview



Tree Farm Program - Larry Nance

Certification of Tree Farms through the American Tree Farm System (ATFS), under the oversight of the American Forest Foundation (AFF), is the oldest and largest voluntary, third party verification process in the United States. Since 1941, ATFS has been certifying the practice of sustainable forestry.



Landowner Account - Polly Foote

A private landowner with over 2,000 timberland acres in Columbia County, Arkansas will share details about her family's reforestation practices and management. Polly has a unique commitment to accountability, details and returns.



GIS Mapping — GeoStor - Shelby Johnson

You will learn quick tips, tricks and little known facts about the GeoStor system that is available for all landowners in Arkansas. Learn how to take full advantage of Map Viewer page to discover and access a wide variety of geographic information within GeoStor including satellite imagery, aerial photography and other map data.



Chemical Reforestation - Greg Hay

Chemical treatment involves hardwood control prior to planting and herbaceous control during the spring of planting (aerial, ground and band application methods). Burning is often included with chemical applications. Returns and method costs will also be discussed.



Mechanical Reforestation - Teddy Reynolds

Mechanical treatment involves tillage of soil through sub-soiling (ripping) and bedding. The various methods combined to accomplish site preparation will be outlined (shearing, raking, bedding, one-pass and two-pass). Returns and costs of methods will also be reviewed.



Best Management Practices (BMP) - Dennis Eagle

Forestry BMPs are important practices, which prevent or reduce the amount of erosion generated by reforestation. BMPs include structural and nonstructural controls, operations and maintenance procedures that can be applied before, during and after reforestation activities.



Reforestation Deductions and Taxation - Paul Spillers

IRS reforestation deductions include a \$10,000 annual deduction per tract, 84 month amortization, and cost base depletion option. The various strengths and weaknesses of each reforestation tax application will be discussed and examples provided. Audience questions are welcome.



Plantation Tour (optional - transportation furnished)

Following the seminar, a short field tour is scheduled for visual examples of successful reforestation techniques. The tour will visit plantations near Magnolia owned by Dan and Polly Foote and Larry and Patricia Swanson.



Dinner & Entertainment (optional - \$50/person)

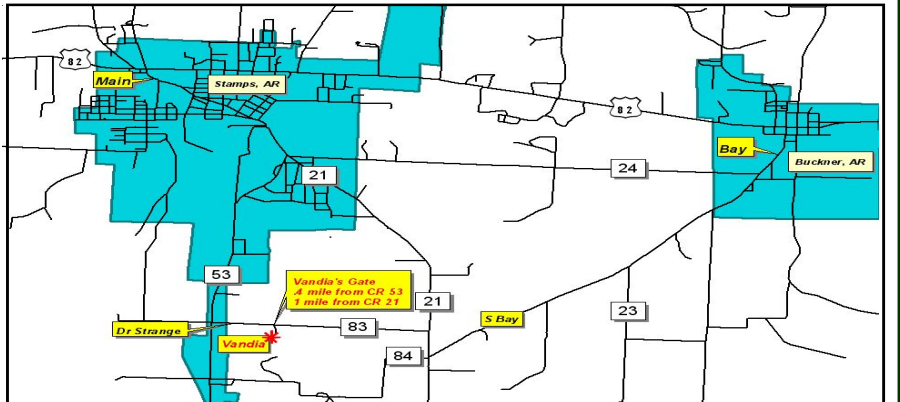
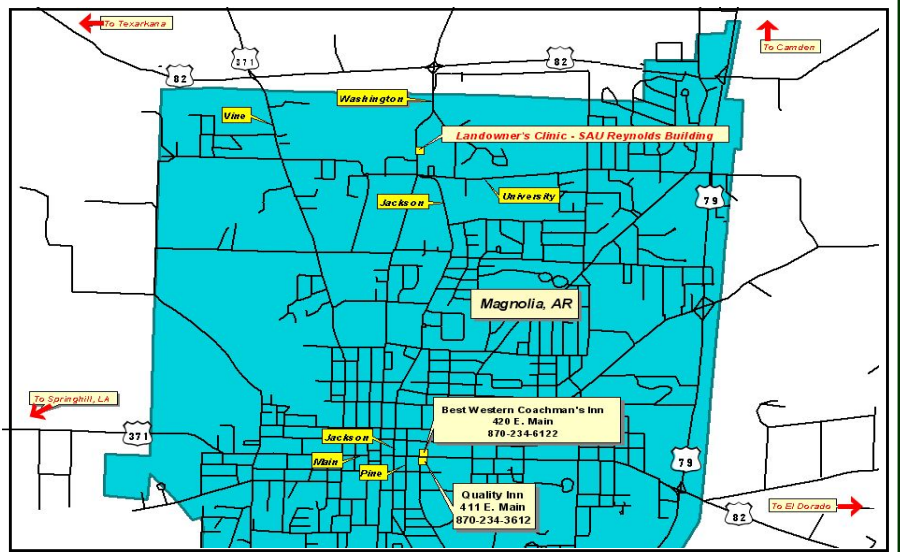
